

Thank you for your interest in the 48th Annual Waldensian Festival. The commemoration of the "Glorious Return" is celebrated all over the world in Waldensian communities, marking the triumphant return of the Waldenses to their native valleys in the Cottian Alps of Italy after years of persecution and exile. The Town of Valdese has had the privilege of honoring this victory through the Annual Waldensian Festival, a weekend long celebration of heritage including bocce, attraction tours, live entertainment, art competitions, footraces, specialty artisan and food vendors, amusement rides, and more! Valdese looks forward to making the 48th Annual Waldensian Festival bigger and better than ever before.

The Festival committee works on this event throughout the year, taking into careful consideration multiple acts of entertainment and hundreds of vendors. Each festival element is poured over, aiming to produce an event in which the entire community take can pride in and enjoy. Friday night's Festival kick-off celebration features a performance by 5-piece variety band, Southside Station. The night will end with an impressive display of fireworks! Festival Saturday includes a lineup of day-long entertainment at Main Stage, from theatrical performances to gravity-defying juggling acts. Saturday's festivities will also feature a bocce tournament, the Waldensian Footrace, attraction tours, worship service, open art competition, free kids zone, and a special performance of the outdoor drama "From This Day Forward". The Festival Finale will begin at 7:00 P.M. as country sensation, Ryan Perry takes the stage for the final performance of the weekend.

Vendor Applications may be submitted through August 1st, 2023. Acceptance for applications received after August 1st will be judged based on the variety of exhibitors at the event, if cancellations arise, or if spaces are still available. Please note: Acceptance is not based solely on date of submission. Decisions for acceptance are based on festival variety, quality of product, space needs, and application deadlines.

Acceptance/denial letters will be mailed out by the Festival Committee *starting* in May. Accepted vendors will receive booth assignment information and Festival day instruction sheet with their acceptance letter. Payment is due no later than August 1st to ensure acceptance. If you have any questions or concerns about your space, please contact us as soon as possible.

To help in reserving your space, when filling out the application, please give thorough information concerning your exhibit (detailed descriptions, photos, or website link are required) and please fill out the entire application legibly. The Vendor Agreement must be signed and returned along with the application. Applications without photos or website link, or signed vendor agreement will not be considered.

All vendors are required to stay until 6:00 P.M. The Festival Committee will make note of vendors who do not stay until this specified time and they will be given low priority acceptance for future festivals.

If your application fails to note that electricity is needed, the Festival Committee will not be responsible if you are placed where electricity is unavailable. If your exhibit requires water, you must state this on the application. Water Stations are available, but there are **NO Water Hookups**, so please come prepared.

Spaces are limited, so submit your application as soon as possible. The Town of Valdese looks forward to showcasing your business and crafts to approximately 15,000 attendees! 2023 Vendor Agreement Rules & Regulations for participating in the Waldensian Festival:

1. The exhibitor agrees to have setup completed by 8:30 A.M. and maintained until 6pm on Saturday August 12th. Food Truck Vendors in the block of 100 Main Street will stay until 9:00 P.M.

2. The exhibitor agrees that no truck/vehicle will be on the reserved Festival Street between the hours of 8:30 A.M. & 6:00 P.M.

3. The exhibitor agrees that the Festival Committee is only providing a booth space. All exhibit displays and shelters, tables,

chairs, tents etc. if desired, must be provided by the exhibitor.

5. Exhibitor agrees that setup will not exceed the 10'x20' booth size.

6. Fire Marshall requires fireproof/retardant tents and they will be inspected. Tents must meet NFPDA 701 standards. Must have manufactured tag displayed. All spaces that are cooking must be equipped with a fire extinguisher. Exhibits that do not meet this requirement may be asked to leave the festival. No refunds will be given. No exceptions.

7. The exhibitor agrees to accept the space(s) assigned by the Festival Committee. There will be no space changes the morning of the festival. If there is an issue with your space, please be sure to address it beforehand. You will be assigned spaces away from similar vendors/vendors with similar items.

8. The exhibitor agrees that the exhibit fee is **non-refundable** due to weather, the exhibitor's decision not to participate, or other causes beyond the control of the Festival Committee.

9. The exhibitor agrees that the Festival Committee officials have the right to evict exhibitors for any reason they deem necessary to maintain a wholesome Festival.

10. The exhibitor agrees to maintain an exhibit that will not be offensive to other exhibitors or Festival patrons. This includes but is not limited to: offensive odors (ex. Smoke), loud noises (ex. Generators, Radios) & structures that might cause injury to others.

11. The exhibitor agrees that generators must be approved by the Festival Committee prior to Festival day.

12. Electricity is not provided unless specified on the application and payment is received.

13. Food Vendors- The Festival Committee provides grease containers and failure to use them will result in a \$100 fine and no admittance to future Waldensian Festivals. They are located behind the Main Stage area on Bobo Street.

14. Vendors must park in designated parking areas only. Vehicles parked in non-approved areas are subject to being towed at their own expense.
